- Delayed Response: Crowd control measures were implemented only after the tragedy.
- Lack of Accountability: Internal inquiry raises concerns over transparency.

The Way Forward

- Independent Investigations instead of internal probes.
- AI-based crowd monitoring and real-time data analytics.
- Proactive planning for high-footfall events and regular safety audits.

The **New Delhi stampede** is a **symptom of systemic failures** in Indian Railways. Without **institutional reforms, independent oversight, and proactive safety planning**, such tragedies

will continue. Passenger safety must be a priority, not an afterthought.
